[PROPOSED] ORDER

Plaintiff's Motion for Attorney's Fees came on regularly for hearing on April 4, 2019, at 8:30 a.m., in Department 4, of the above-entitled court located at 4050 Main Street, Riverside, California 92501, the Honorable Daniel A. Ottolia, presiding. Plaintiff moved the Court for an award of \$804,043.74 in lodestar attorney fees plus a 1.8 lodestar in the amount of \$643,234.99.

Roger Kirnos and Christopher Swanson of Knight Law Group, LLP and Hallen D. Rosner of Rosner, Barry & Babbit, LLP appeared on behalf of Plaintiff Leonard Coon, and Peter J. Van Zandt of LeClairRyan appeared on behalf of Defendant Ford Motor Company. Having read the motion, the memoranda, the declarations filed by the parties, and having heard oral argument of counsel, the Court rules as follows:

- 1. Plaintiff's Motion for Attorney's Fees is GRANTED, in part;
- 2. The Court finds the number of hours billed to be reasonable;
- The Court finds that the hourly rates of Plaintiff's attorneys are reasonable for this
 community, except that the Court reduces those hourly rates in excess of \$500 down to
 \$500/hour;
- 4. The Court declines to grant a lodestar multiplier;
- 5. Plaintiff is awarded lodestar attorney's fees in the amount of \$731.885.25.
